Known as the artisans’ quarter, this tour is a relaxing walk among the narrow streets of the Oltrarno District. Loved by locals, this part of the city is less crowded and has an authentic spirit. Our guide will take you to visit some artisans working on masterpieces of art, for example silver, gold, perfumes, leather, paper, mosaics and so on...
